ABSTRACT

The responsible party particularly the father must comply with the court's order to execute alimony. When someone must pay child support a through the court's order must be followed. Nevertheless, there is also the father who is unable to pay the previous maintenance order. The mother on the other hand requested a rise in the alimony rate because the existing amount is insufficient. As a result, a change in order is necessary and the court will assess this in light of the children's present requirements throughout the trial. This study aims to assess the judge's judgment about whether to increase, raise, or retain the amount of alimony. A bibliographic analysis of documents, including fiqh books, legal statutes, articles, journals, and scientific writing, was used as the approach in this study. Also, the Syariah Court officers in different states were questioned using the interview technique about the statistics of case registration and settlement as well as the explanation of case instances. The four northern in Malaysia states of Perlis, Kedah, Penang, and Perak are included in the study's scope along with the study's three-year statistical period from 2018 to 2020. According to the study's research, the mother's requests for adjustments resulted in more changes to the increase in child support that is 47%, of the decrease is 41% and only 12% of the retention. This is a result of the fact that youngsters are growing older and need for increase adequate needs.
